He has worked on various projects throughout Southwest Florida and is familiar with the design and permitting procedures of the local municipalities as well as the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). John's primary experience includes EEO, field inspection, drilled shaft installations, utility coordination and inspection including construction engineering and inspection (CEI) of transportation improvement projects. He has served as project administrator and contract support specialist. This wide range of experience provides John a firm understanding of the overall process involved with transportation improvement projects from inception to final completion.

CEI Experience

- ↪ Gasparilla Rd (CR 771), Charlotte County – Senior inspector for this CM at Risk project including 2.5 miles of 2 to 4 lane widening with associated utility relocation, drainage, signalization, street lighting and a new pre-fab deck span bridge over the Butterford Canal.
- ↪ Three Oaks Parkway - John's responsibilities included: supervision of field inspection staff, all phases of roadway construction inspection including concrete testing, soils testing, drainage inspection, soil density testing, and utility inspection. In addition, John scheduled any outside testing that was necessary and coordinated testing and inspection between CEI and the contractor. Also, he reviewed the monthly contractor pay request prior to the Project Engineer signing off on it, and reviewed submittals and RFI's before forwarding them to the appropriate parties.
- ↪ Alico Road from I-75 to U.S.41, Lee County - John's responsibilities included supervision of field inspection staff, all phases of roadway construction inspection including concrete testing, soils testing, drainage inspection, soil density testing and utility inspection. Also oversee inspection services for the construction of two miles of the Briarcliff Canal.
- ↪ Southwest 6 & 7 Utility Expansion Project Areas 1 & 2, City of Cape Coral - John is the CEI construction manager for this project which includes providing utility improvements to approximately 1,100 existing residential properties in Cape Coral. John is currently providing construction inspection and oversight for approximately 53,000 linear feet of gravity sewer main, 56,000 linear feet of potable water main, 58,000 linear feet of irrigation main and 5,400 linear feet of storm drain improvements.
- ↪ Immokalee Road/C.R. 846 from I-75 to approximately 0.5 mile east of C.R. 951, Collier County – John's responsibilities included all phases of roadway construction inspection including concrete testing, soils testing, drainage inspection, soil density testing and utility inspection.
- ↪ Treeline Avenue Pump Station, City of Fort Myers - Responsibilities included construction observation, keeping daily logs of all material used and ensuring that the contractor was following the proper specifications during construction.
- ↪ State Road 776 from Dearborn Street to Keyway Road, Sarasota County – John's responsibilities included all phases of roadway construction inspection including concrete testing, soils testing, drainage inspection, soil density testing and utility inspection.
- ↪ Lake Alfred Bike Trail, Lake Alfred - This is a hybrid project for FDOT out of the Bartow Operations Center. John is the senior inspector for this project. This project consists of 1 mile of a newly constructed asphalt bike/multi use trail with some drainage improvements, landscaping, irrigation and sod.
- ↪ Ben C. Pratt Six Mile Cypress Parkway Widening from Daniels Parkway to 3.1 miles north, for the Lee County Department of Transportation and the Florida Department of Transportation - John was the contract control specialist for HDR on this project. This project consists of the proposed widening of Six Mile Cypress Parkway from Daniels Road to 3.1 miles north. Construction activities include utility adjustments, multifaceted maintenance of traffic phases, underground drainage construction, roadway embankment, stabilized sub-grade, base construction, paving operations, lighting and signalization. Ben C. Pratt Six Mile Cypress Parkway is being funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) and the Lee County Department of Transportation. This contract is subject to the criteria and conditions established under the ARRA as well as the specifications and conditions of the Florida Department of Transportation and the Lee County Department of Transportation.
