Serving as design engineer and senior inspector on many of these projects has given John an understanding of what it takes to successfully complete both the design and construction phases of a project.

Relevant CEI Experience

- Helms Roadway Extension, Hendry County - John is currently serving as the Senior Inspector and Assistant PA for approximately three miles of new four-lane urban roadway improvements. His roles include soil density testing and sampling, concrete testing, review of pay requests, shop drawings and RFI's. This project includes the construction of four box culverts and one box culvert extension. John also served as a design team member on this project.
- County Road 720, Glades County - John participated in both the design and construction inspection for approximately two miles of roadway resurfacing and drainage improvements. This project was completed on time and on budget.
- County Road 78 Phase III, Hendry County - John served as both a design team member and inspector for the construction of approximately three miles of roadway widening, associated drainage and milling and resurfacing. This project has been completed.
